
## Energy Commodities Update For Close of Business February 7, 2013


#### Market Update & Outlook



Weather: Snow from Winter Storm Nemo works into northern New York and northern New England Thursday night as an area of rain and wintry mix spreads into the Virginias, Maryland, Delaware, southern Pennsylvania and southern New Jersey from a southern storm. Friday and Friday night two storms combine into a huge nor'easter east of New Jersey and southeast of Massachusetts. Heavy snow and strong winds produce blizzard conditions across New England Friday night into Saturday. Parts of New England could see 2 to 3 feet of snow. Travel disruptions are likely and could last for days. - Widespread power outages are likely. Preparations for Nemo should be completed by AM Friday. Rain changes over to snow in southeast New York, New York City, New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania Friday evening as the Nemo grows stronger. From eastern Pennsylvania to the southern New England coast, including New York City, snowfall totals of 6 to 10 inches are forecast. Across Upstate New York snowfall ranges from 6 to 12 inches along the Pennsylvania border to over a foot in central and northern sections. Nemo will produce coastal flooding at high tide Fri. evening Long Is. and coastal New England. Wind chills could fall to between 0 and 10 degrees around Boston Friday night.

Storage to compare with 5 year range: Working gas in storage was 2,684 Bcf as of Friday, February 1, 2013, according to EIA estimates. This represents a net decline of 118 Bcf from the previous week. Stocks were 226 Bcf less than last year at this time and 351 Bcf above the 5-year average of 2,333 Bcf. In the East Region, stocks were 118 Bcf above the 5-year average following net withdrawals of 88 Bcf.





Market Watch: At the Nymex, the March 2013 and
April 2013 contracts both ended the week up
slightly. The March 2013 and April 2013 New York
Mercantile Exchange (Nymex) contracts rose yesterday
by 2.5 percent and 2.3 percent, respectively, over
closing prices on Wednesday, January 30. The March
2013 contract closed vesterday at \$3,418 per MMRtu

comparted to \$3.335 per MMBtu last Wednesday, while the April 2013 Nymex contract closed yesterday at \$3.464 per MMBtu, versus \$3.385 per MMBtu last Wednesday.
