


- No snow accumulation close to the Gt. Lakes
- Snow occurs most of the day in the mountains with 1 to 4 inches of accumulation possible.

- Blustery conditions are expected throughout the region with occasional gusts over 30 mph.

- High temperatures range from the 30s and 40s in the higher elevations to the middle 50s along the coast.

Storage to compare with 5 year range: Working gas in storage was 3,831 Bcf as of Friday, November 4, 2011, according to EIA estimates. This represents a net increase of 37 Bcf from the previous week. Stocks were 6 Bcf less than last year at this time and 215 Bcf above the 5-year average of 3,616 Bcf. In the East Region, stocks were 48 Bcf above the 5-year average following net injections of 16 Bcf.

Market Watch: The NYMEX near-month (December 2011) contract lost 9.7 cents this week, falling from \$3.749 per MMBtu last Wednesday to \$3.652 per MMBtu yesterday. During its tenure as the near-month contract, which began on October 28, the December 2011 contract

has lost 27.1 cents, or about 7 percent of its value. The 12-month strip (the average of the 12 contracts between December 2011 and November 2012) also fell this week, dropping from \$3.945 per MMBtu last Wednesday to \$3.825 per MMBtu yesterday
